Choosing a Marquee

A marquee can be the perfect option for that special occasion you'd like to host at home. Look for a marquee without guy ropes that guests might fall over, or centre poles that get in the way of seating arrangements. A white marquee will let more light through than any other, and of course the you need to be sure that it will be in good condition.



Marquees can have plain walls or clear see-through arched window walls.



What else will we need?

Tables, chairs, lighting, heating, flooring and ??? (tablecloths, glasses?) can all be provided with your marquee.

Will we have room in our garden?

There is often more space than you realise. A marquee can go over grass or patio, linked either directly to your house or have covered walkways. Use it to maximise the space in your house or garden.

Would it be warm enough?

Heaters can be provided that will keep you warm as toast. Today's strong aluminium framed marquees will withstand strong winds and even snow loadings!

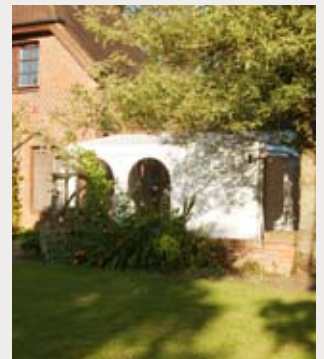
What about a BBQ?

With an 'L' – shaped marquee you can create a 'Courtyard style' area, where you can enjoy dining 'Al Fresco', whilst still having shelter from prevailing winds. Depending on weather conditions you can fully open the walls on a hot sunny day, so the marquee acts as a shade canopy – or if the weather's not so good, walls, doors and windows can be closed.

Decorating your marquee

Use flowers, balloons or bunting to add colour to the day.
